

The benefits of being part of the European network for active participation in cultural activities

A large number of voluntary and paid staff and artists are employed in a wide range of associations to provide arts based activities for about 38% of the people in the member states. Amateo, is the European Network for Active Participation in Cultural Activities that works to represent those many organisations. The Network was founded in 2008 as the multi-disciplinary European organisation within the field of participatory arts and cultural activities. We have [38 national and regional umbrellas and associations](#) from 15 EU member states and 2 non-EU countries, with contacts to a huge network of regional and local associations within the European field of amateur arts, socio-cultural and voluntary arts and culture activities.

Our new programme Arts Take Part – supported by Creative Europe aims to grow and strengthen the network over the next four years. We have a team of 20 people working part time across Europe to help us achieve this aim.
